HCP package increases

Following the Fair Work Commission's decision on the Aged Care Work Value case of a 15% increase to award wages for aged care workers, the Australian Government is increasing the home care subsidy and some supplements by 11.9% (including annual indexation) from 1 July 2023. This includes:

- Basic subsidy
- Dementia and cognition supplement
- Veterans' supplement
- Viability supplement
- Top-up supplement



Annual review of fee reductions and waivers

This year's review has been delayed, but all consumers currently in receipt of fee reductions and waivers will continue to receive it until the review is completed.



Allied health services

The establishment of our Allied Health Services is underway with the appointment of Annemarie Thompson and Eva Eva Schneeberger as Occupational therapist and registered nurse respectively. We are expecting hopefully, at least two more registered nurses as well as a number of therapy assistants to join the team.

We are now able to do Rowland Universal Dementia Assessment Scale (RUDAS) assessments, functional capacity and various other assessments in-house.

Turkey Earthquake Appeal

We are pleased to advise you that we collected \$15,370, which has been transferred to the Bridge to Türkiye Fund (BTF), a USA-based non-profit organization for their Project CATE (Child Amputees of Türkiye Earthquake). The project aims to bring a new outlook on life to those kids affected by the earthquake. Medical doctors on both ends of this humanitarian

bridge, in the US and Türkiye, are working together to provide a long-lasting medical support system for these children.

Project CATE focuses on children who have suffered amputations due to the earthquake. BTF aims to provide prostheses to amputee children aged between 0-21. In addition to the prosthesis, BTF will provide scholarships to these children until they graduate from university. With
